1. General Information

1.1. Organizer

- 1.1.1. The 2nd World Yak-52 Aerobatic Championship 2009 will be organized on behalf of the Fédération Aéronautique Internationale (FAI) by Aero Club of Lithuania and Lithuanian Aerobatic Federation (LASF).
- 1.1.2. The operational organizer is *Žmogus Paukštis* (*The Birdman*), a public institution.

1.2. Date and Place

- 1.2.1. The event will take place at the Rojūnai Airfield (EYRO) in Lithuania, 16 km South-West from Panevėžys city, from **25th June** until **5th July, 2009**.
- 1.2.2. Airfield information: See appendix 1.

1.3. International Access to the Site

The international visitors can arrive by airlines to international airports of Lithuania located in Vilnius (150 km) and Kaunas (100 km) or that in Riga in Latvia (150 km). For more information about the venue please visit the website <u>www.yakwac.info</u>.

1.4. Local transport

1.4.1. The organizer provides transportation between the accommodation place and the Rojūnai Airfield.

1.5. Accommodation and meals

- 1.5.1. All participants and officials will be accommodated during the championship. Hotels and country houses will be located within a 20 km radius from the airfield. Options for single and double rooms will be provided. The exact place of accommodation will be confirmed for participants after the registration.
- 1.5.2. The entry fee includes a breakfast, lunch, dinner for the championship period and dinners at the Opening and Closing ceremonies. The breakfast will be provided at the hotel; the lunch and dinner will be provided at the airfield.

- 2.2. The schedule above may be changed due to technical or organizational issues or weather conditions.
- 2.3. The time is provided according to the local time (LT = UTC + 3 hours).

3. Regulations

- 3.1. The Championship will be conducted according to the following rules:
 - FAI Sporting Code General Section; FAI Sporting Code Section 6 part 1; CIVA Regulations; Flight Rules Issued by Lithuanian Aviation Authorities; Local Regulations.

4. Working Language

- 4.1. English will be official working, communicating and correspondence language.
- 4.2. Lithuanian and Russian languages are accepted for the communication.

5. Entry Requirements

5.1. Competing Pilots and team members

- 5.1.1. The championship is open to all pilots who are members of the FAI Member Clubs.
- 1.1.1. FAI Member Club National Aero Club may send a team of competing pilots up to a
- maximum of 6. 1.1.2. All competitors have to be a holders of: Valid Pilot Licence Valid Aerobatic Flight Permission (Sporting Licence) Valid Medical Certificate Valid for EU Personal Insurance Policy
- 1.1.3. Solo entries are allowed for NAC.
- 1.1.4. Number of Team members and Observers (chief delegate, team manager, coach, doctor, interpreter, mechanic, relative of competitors) is not limited.

1.2. Aircraft

- 1.2.1. Competing aircraft must be the Yak-52.
- 1.2.2. Pilots are competing with their own or rented aircraft. Organizers can advice contact information for local aircraft rent.
- 1.2.3. The following documents must be presented to the Organizer for every competing aircraft:
 - A valid Certificate of Airworthiness or equivalent document issued by a relevant aviation authority of the aircraft registration country;
 - A valid Aircraft Registration Certificate or equivalent document issued by a relevant aviation authority of the aircraft registration country;
 - A Certificate of Insurance against the Third Party Liability valid for the EU for the period of staying there (currently 3.000.000 SDR).
- 1.2.4. The Organizer shall supply Participants with the fuel and oil for competition flights:

Fuel 100 LL

Oil MS 20

- 4.2. Training flights may be carried out in the official Aerobatic Box in accordance to the list based upon the order of arrival on the spot.


